



Dear NanoCount 1000 Owner,

Thank you for your purchase!

In your package you should have all items you ordered. You will notice a zip-tie through the hole on the counter, where you will normally place a lock. You will need to cut that off and slide the case off of the counter. The counter will have a protective rubber cap on the nozzle where the rubber hose will be attached. You may want to keep the rubber cap on the nozzle while the counter is not used to prevent anything from getting into the air switch, especially if the counter is stored in a wet or dirty environment.

Your counter is fully functional right out of the box. It may even have some counts in it when you receive it that may have accumulated during shipping.
